- Basic Native Flute modes, techniques, and ornaments
- Basic improvisation techniques: call-&-response, solo over drone & repeated patterns
- Song forms such as A/B/A contrast, blues, and rounds.

Expressing yourself through music is as natural a means of communication as speaking. All people are musical and each person's level of musicality depends only on their level of experience in music-making. Regardless of your current level of experience, if you want to bring your flute playing to a new level, this is the workshop to attend!
